

## Non-Party Transcript Request

Anyone who is not a party (the Requester) who seeks to obtain a transcript from a court proceeding in the South Carolina Administrative Law Court must complete a request form and email the signed request to the court reporting service and the Clerk's Office. The Chief Judge will review the form, and at his discretion, will either grant or deny your request. You will be notified by email of the Court's decision with a completed copy of this form. If the request is approved, the Requester may then proceed with ordering the transcript from the court reporter in accordance with their payment procedures.
