**ORDER**

Pursuant to section 1-23-570 of the South Carolina Code of Laws and in light of the COVID-19 pandemic:

**IT IS ORDERED** that until subsequent order by the Chief Judge of the South Carolina Administrative Law Court, appearances at all trials and hearings at the address of the Court, 1205 Pendleton Street, Suite 224, Columbia, South Carolina 29201, are limited to the attorneys, their clients, and necessary witnesses. If any other person wishes to be allowed into the courtroom, a request must be made in writing no later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the scheduled hearing/trial to the presiding judge. The person will be allowed into the courtroom only after permission is granted by the presiding judge.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the presiding judge will be allowed to establish and limit the physical location of attorneys, their clients, witnesses, and any other persons authorized by the Court to be in the courtroom.
